

Bronze ironmongery with hand-finished antique brass panelling and detail adds a gorgeous and subtle extra dimension.











Bottom House Farm


Bags of space and statement textures are the standout features here: part of a stunning conversion in the Berkshire countryside.

It's the combination of materials that really sings. Alongside reused elements from the original barn, plus polished concrete worktops and patinated corrugated iron, we added an unexpected canvas of colour and contrast - through the stunning Lilac Milas marble splashback.

Packed with ingenious touches that maximise light and space, this beautiful design cleverly turns an ordinary basement into a luxurious and functional kitchen. Featuring an elegant walk-in pantry and sleek island with antique brass, the careful mix of materials - including Leathered White Fantasy quartzite worktop and eucalyptus bookmatched veneer on the floor-to-ceiling storage - creates a serene and stylish feel.










Robinson




Oliver


Sondergaard






Howell

Running the full length of the room, it dominates the view from inside and out - and impresses from any angle, with extra-wide pan drawers and striking African Fusion Quartzite wraps to bookend it perfectly.

The secret to keeping this stunning space looking beautiful day-to-day? A fully equipped back pantry, which takes storage pressures and countertop appliances out of the equation.









Studio WD

A timeless kitchen for a period style new-build property. The grandeur of the architecture suited a classic Shaker design with a contemporary twist: all achieved without stinting on the functions and features a hardworking family kitchen demands, including multiple cooking areas, drinks fridge and breakfast area, and separate sinks.

Clean lines and elegant colour tones create a modern feel, offsetting the more traditional details, while the Sub Zero fridge, freezer and wine-cooler combination lends the space a pro-kitchen flavour. Elsewhere, a standalone bi-folding breakfast cabinet keeps gadgets and appliances tucked away, or opens up to add a note of contrast, revealing the warm wooden textures inside.

Can a knockout modern kitchen harmonise with Listed 19th-century architecture?
Visit one former Dock Master's House in London and you'll be in no doubt that it can. Symmetry and sympathy were the watchwords for this project, which features an antique brass metal island curved to match the bay window, and a wealth of discreetly organised appliances and storage space - including a large fridge and several ovens.



















Carey Newton

Symmetry was key to the concept: with a central sink at the rear, and a second sink bookending the main horizontal lines. There's no shortage of storage space too, with specific pull-out drawers for crockery and cutlery as well as a pantry store. Wall units are clever bi-folding lift-ups, making it easy to put everything away from the dishwasher below.






Chapman






